



Sedan — comfortable chairs with distinctive form

By creating the Sedan upholstered series year, Jan Armgardt provided Wittmann with a sophisticated line that has aroused universal enthusiasm. The German furniture designer has now derived a comfortable chair series and table from this distinctive formal language.

Like the upholstered models, the Sedan chairs are marked by a striking back with an almost three-dimensional effect and elaborate decorative piping. The latter offers yet further proof of the skills of Wittmann's craftsmen.

The base has a decisive influence on the character of the furniture. Metal legs make the chair look modern and elegant, whereas wood has a clear and timeless, yet comfortable and welcoming effect. This means that the new line is suited to many home and architectural uses. Both models can be ordered either with or without armrests.

The table blends harmoniously with the suite and rounds it off. The table top and legs are made of wood, and continue the formal language of the chairs. The finish is either black-stained ash, which does particular justice to the natural grain of the wood, or warm, light-coloured natural maple. The table is available in dimensions of 180 x 90 or 220 x 90 cm.
